Hello Folks,

I am seeking clarification around emergency shelter intake and criteria for being admitted to a shelter.

Based on what I recently found out, people calling the shelter line may have to demonstrate the need for emergency shelter. As part of this intake process they would have to provide three months' worth of financials, presumably to determine if they are deserving of shelter. If I understand it properly, a person who calls the shelter line but has \$5000 (or a thousand dollars) in savings may find him/herself unable to access emergency shelter because s/he has financial means to access other arrangements such as a hotel. If this is the case, we are basically requiring an individual to exhaust all financial means and render him/herself destitute.

In another example, an individual at tent city had moved out of his NLHC unit because he was being threatened by a drug dealer/gang next door (his words, not mine). He was denied shelter because he already had a place, regardless of how unsafe he perceived it to be. He ended up at the encampment next to the colonial building.

Then there is the issue of "travellers," people who may have moved to NL from other jurisdictions and have not applied for MCP. They do not qualify for emergency shelter. I spoke to one individual at the Colonial Building who is there because emergency shelter is unavailable to him.

Am I correct in these statements? Would it be possible to have a copy of the policy/procedures as well as any forms for shelter intake?

Thank you for your attention to this matter, and I look forward to your reply.
