Update to the board re protesters – July 4, 2024

Good evening,

There are some developments to report on regarding the protest.

Yesterday, there were a number of tents brought into the lobby of the Arts and Administration building. This is concerning from a life-health-safety perspective and a request was made to the St. John's Fire Department for an inspection. They have provided orders, including that the tents are to be removed from the interior and some removed from the exterior, as well as the clean up of the clutter in the lobby in general.

As you are likely aware, on Tuesday, the University of Toronto received an injunction from the Ontario Superior Court against their protesters who had set up an encampment. The protesters were given a deadline to vacate and this occurred without incident. All of the issues raised in this case apply equally to the protesters on the St. John's campus. This afternoon, our General Counsel sent a letter to the protester's lawyer indicating such and requesting he advise his clients that the encampment and occupation cannot continue and they should vacate the building and remove the encampment.

Tomorrow, we will be releasing a public statement that calls for an end to the occupation and encampment. The statement outlines our commitment to freedom of expression, academic freedom and the right to protest. It also outlines our commitments, such as providing the board with the documents shared by the students at our June 18 meeting, reviewing the Statements of Investment Policy and Objectives, evaluating investment firms' commitment to ESG as it relates to investment strategies and support student scholars at risk through a new bursary program.

We will keep you updated on these developments.

Dear Dr. Bose ,

In March, following a non-binding motion in the House of Commons, the Canadian government committed to pausing its approval of future arms export permits to Israeli. In this decision, Canada joined the Netherlands, Japan, Spain, Belgium, Italy and other countries in either immediately halting sales and shipments or stopping future permitting. The reason these countries have taken this unprecedented step is the overwhelming evidence that, in the wake of the atrocities committed by Hamas and other actors on October 7, the state of Israel is, in the Gaza strip and the West Bank, engaging in war crimes and the violation of international humanitarian rights.

In a report issued on June 12, the UN's 'International Commission of Inquiry on the Occupied Palestinian Territory, including East Jerusalem, and Israel' found that Palestinian armed groups are responsible for war crimes committed in Israel. They also found that Israeli authorities are responsible for war crimes and crimes against humanity committed during the military operations and attacks in Gaza since 7 October 2023. Oxfam; Amnesty; Human Rights Watch; B'Tselem – these organization have examined the evidence and reached the basic conclusion that the International Court of Justice (ICJ) reached earlier this year: the charges levelled by South Africa against Israel are credible and, were they to be proven, could well fall under the United Nations' Convention on Genocide. The court ordered Israel to take steps to "protect against further, severe and irreparable harm to the rights of the Palestinian people." No such steps have been taken. On May 20, the International Criminal Court (ICC) issued arrest warrants for three senior Hamas leaders and for Israel's Prime Minister and Minister of Defence, on charges of war crimes and crimes against humanity. On 24 May, by 13 votes to two, the ICJ ordered an immediate halt to Israel's offensive in Rafah. There was a broad consensus among legal experts that the order requires Israel to halt its offensive immediately, an order that has been ignored.

International courts and human rights groups cannot stop the war and human rights violations; they can only bring to bear their reason, their powers of judgement, and the limited tools they have. The same goes for MUN's students, and what they've decided, obviously, is to respond with sit-ins, encampments and building 'occupation.' In my view their case is sound and their demands reasonable. I can't imagine they want to spend the summer inside the Arts Admin building; but I can imagine they will.

War crimes and human rights violations are being committed in the Gaza strip. Part of what allows this to happen are weapons and systems of war sold to the state of Israel. And so, the students are simply, straightforwardly, openly, reasonably, and morally asking MUN/MUNFA to divest from those companies in the weapons and war business that are supplying the state of Israel with the tools its uses in carrying out war crimes and human rights violations. Again, the governments of Canada, the Netherlands, Spain, Belgium, Japan and others reached the decision they can no longer in good conscience send weapons to a state that is using them not for the purpose of self-defence but to violate human rights and carryout what is plausibly a genocidal campaign against a people inside its borders. How then can [redacted] university continue to refuse the obvious path of divestment?

Good evening,

There are some developments to report on regarding the protest. Yesterday, there were a number of tents brought into the lobby of the Arts and Administration building. This is concerning from a life-health-safety perspective and a request was made to the St. John's Fire Department for an inspection. They have provided orders, including that the tents are to be removed from the interior and some removed from the exterior, as well as the clean up of the clutter in the lobby in general.

As you are likely aware, on Tuesday, the University of Toronto received an injunction from the Ontario Superior Court against their protesters who had set up an encampment. The protesters were given a deadline to vacate and this occurred without incident. All of the issues raised in this case apply equally to the protesters on the St. John's campus. This afternoon, our General Counsel sent a letter to the protester's lawyer indicating such and requesting he advise his clients that the encampment and occupation cannot continue and they should vacate the building and remove the encampment.

Tomorrow, we will be releasing a public statement that calls for an end to the occupation and encampment. The statement outlines our commitment to freedom of expression, academic freedom and the right to protest. It also outlines our commitments, such as providing the board with the documents shared by the students at our June 18 meeting, reviewing the Statements of Investment Policy and Objectives, evaluating investment firms' commitment to ESG as it relates to investment strategies and support student scholars at risk through a new bursary program.

We will keep you updated on these developments.

The Board of Regents, which includes faculty, alumni, students and appointed representatives, has also committed to reviewing the documentation shared by the students in the June 18 meeting.

Student protesters are referring to their meetings with Memorial as a negotiation. A negotiation, however, requires both sides to be willing to listen and respond to the concerns that the other has raised. The commitments outlined above represent tangible changes that Memorial is making in good faith to improve transparency, continue its commitment to responsible investing and support students, scholars and staff.

Students cannot continue to live in a building or camp on grounds that are meant for work and study. This aligns with the decision released on Tuesday, July 2, by the Ontario Superior Court in *U of T v. Doe et al.*

We expect protesters to respect this court decision and to end the occupation of the Arts and Administration building and the encampment on the St. John's campus.

**Subject: Update on student protest/Arts and Administration building access**

On the evening of July 5, 2024, buildings on the St. John's campus were closed at the usual time. This included the Arts and Administration building, where a group of student protestors had set up an occupation. Since June 7, a small group of students have been occupying the lobby of the building to the exclusion of others and sleeping there each night.

A July 4 inspection by the St. John's Regional Fire Department resulted in a Fire Prevention Inspection Report that outlined a number of orders around health, life and safety associated with the protestors' encampment and occupation. On the same day, student protestors were notified, via their legal counsel, that they cannot continue to live in a building or camp on grounds meant for work and study.

This action aligns with the reasons for the decision released on Tuesday, July 2, by the Ontario Superior Court in *U of T v. Doe et al.* While an Ontario case, the legal principles around property ownership and control of property are equally applicable here. In the ruling, Justice Markus Koehnen found that the protestors had appropriated space and taken away the university's ability to control what occurs on its own property. The University of Toronto protestors respected the finding and ended their occupation. Precedents set by other courts in Canada are relevant and commonly used in other jurisdictions when the issues of law are the same.

On July 5, when the Arts and Administration building was set to close, Campus Enforcement and Patrol (CEP) officers reminded student protestors of the university's position and the expectation that they vacate the building at closing time.

A number of protestors chose to leave the building. Three protestors did not, and the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary (RNC) responded to assist. Over the course of approximately 90 minutes, students were informed, by both CEP and RNC officers, of their options and the students were given every opportunity to leave. Those three students were escorted from the building by CEP without force or incident. They are each facing a single charge of petty trespassing.

The Arts and Administration building will remain closed for the weekend for cleaning. Our focus is on maintaining a safe environment for all. The university will follow its policies, guidelines and procedures to ensure our community remains a place where diverse perspectives can be discussed and where students, faculty and staff are able to use shared facilities unimpeded.

## Key messages for use by the Board of Regents

July 6, 2024

### *Occupation/encampment*

- The occupation and encampment by a small group of student protesters was increasingly disruptive to members of our community and is in no way supported by Memorial University.
- Memorial must remain a place where diverse perspectives can be discussed and where students, faculty and staff are able to use shared facilities unimpeded.
- Students cannot continue to live in a building or camp on grounds that are meant for work and study. This aligns with the decision released on Tuesday, July 2, by the Ontario Superior Court in *U of T v. Doe et al.* Precedents set by other courts in Canada are relevant and commonly used in other jurisdictions when the issues of law are the same.
- On Friday, July 5, Memorial closed all campus buildings at their usual time, including the Arts and Administration building. Campus Enforcement Officers reminded student protesters of the university's position and the expectation that they vacate the building at closing time of 10 pm.
- A number of protesters chose to leave the building. Three protestors did not. The Royal Newfoundland Constabulary responded to assist. Officers informed protestors of their options, and the students were given every opportunity to leave. Those three students who refused were escorted from the building by Campus Enforcement without incident. They are each facing a single charge of petty trespassing.
- A person who contravenes the *Petty Trespass Act* is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$10 or more than \$200. This is not a criminal offence and the three students who face the charge of petty trespassing will not have a criminal record.

### *University response to protest demands*

- The university has heard from protest organizers, and members of the community who have both supported and disagreed with the protest.
- Memorial's leaders have been considering how to best uphold the principles of freedom of expression, academic freedom, the requirements of the university's fiduciary obligation, and the university's core mission of teaching, research and public engagement.
- Memorial published an update to the university community on Friday that outlined its commitments to transparency, responsible investing and student support. These commitments are tangible changes made in good faith.
- The Board of Regents has committed to reviewing the documentation shared by student protesters in the June 18 meeting and the documentation has been shared with the Board.
- Memorial must remain an environment where all students, faculty and staff feel comfortable and can thrive. This requires creating the conditions in which diverse perspectives can be respectfully shared and explored—even if these perspectives

challenge prevailing political or social norms. This ensures a vibrant academic environment where ideas can be freely expressed and critically examined.

- University administration should not and will not take a political position that inhibits freedom of expression or academic freedom by directing staff, faculty members or students to conform to specific ideological viewpoints or limit their research, study or scholarship opportunities.
- Our focus is on maintaining a safe environment for all. The university will follow its policies, guidelines and procedures to ensure our community remains a place where diverse perspectives can be discussed and where students, faculty and staff are able to use shared facilities unimpeded.

#### *Allegations of a privacy breach*

- Memorial has a process for investigating potential privacy breaches that will be followed in this instance.
- The university, including the Board of Regents, will not comment further while this matter is under investigation.
