We have reviewed the Commissioner's Report A-2025-015 of March 20, 2025. Pursuant to ss.49(1) of the ATIPPA, 2015, I am writing to advise that Memorial University will be applying to Court for a Declaration that it does not have to comply with the Recommendations set out in the Report.

Pursuant to ss.49(3)(a), a complainant has a right under section 54 to appeal a decision to grant or refuse access to a record or part of a record. An appeal must be made to the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador within 10 business days of receipt of this letter.
