
Tina,



We are in agreement as indicated in the second paragraph.

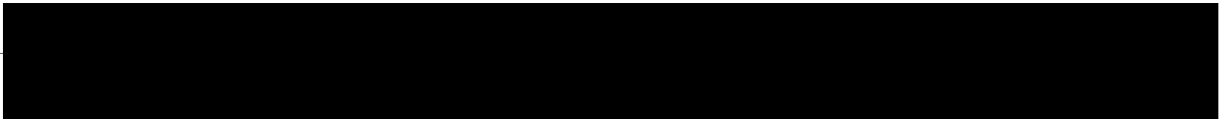
