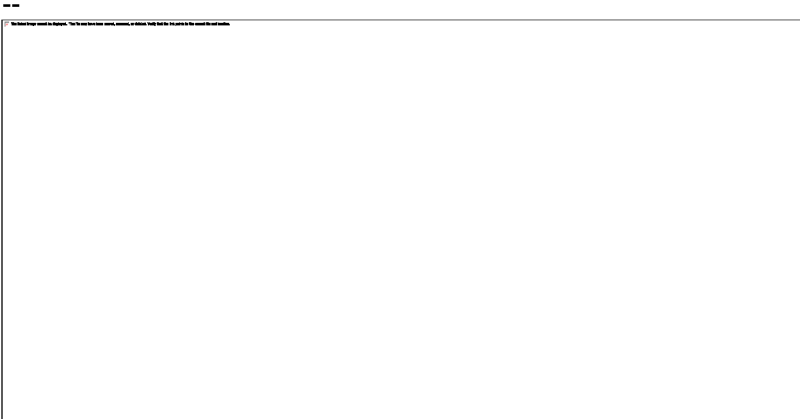

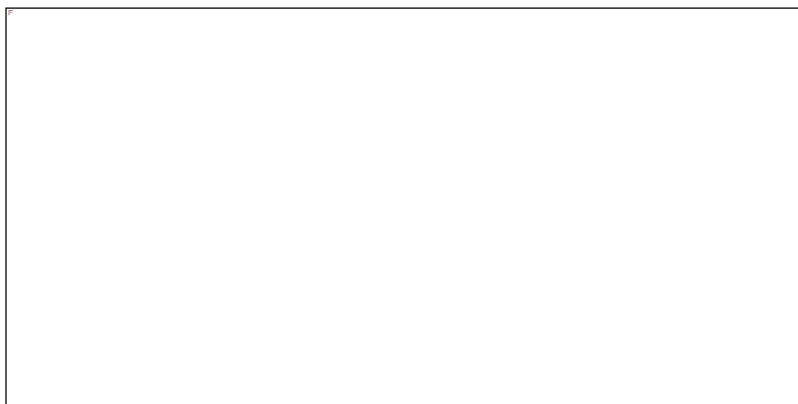

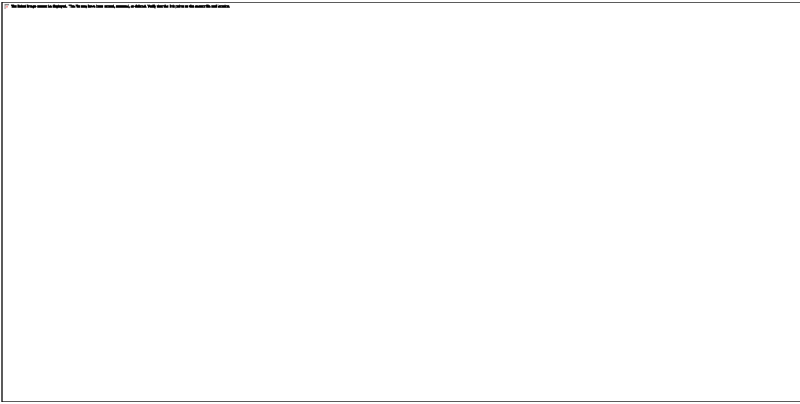

Minister Stoodley,

I'm writing today to see if there is any assistance you might be able to provide in obtaining a lottery licence. I'll try to keep this email brief, while still providing the adequate details.

**The quick summary is that our Foundation, the ImpactYYT Foundation, has had a lot of trouble with the lottery division while trying to coordinate a fundraiser on behalf of the 2025 Canada Games Legacy Fund. Two months into this process, there does not seem to be an end in sight and feedback has been vague. We are running out of time.**

[REDACTED] I decided to start my own charitable foundation, ImpactYYT Foundation Inc. with two other individuals, Peter Laing and Ian Dawe. [REDACTED]

On April 11, we submitted our first communication with our entire package to the lottery division - this included signed contracts, sample tickets, certifications from the electronic raffle provided, and

screenshots of checkout pages. All requirements from the lottery division. Our goal was to fundraise for the 2025 Canada Games, and had a signed agreement with them that was also provided.

Since then, we have done nothing but jump through hoops and been given vague feedback and instruction from the lottery division on how to potentially remedy the situation. Eventually, we were told we could not fundraise for the 2025 Canada Games, and would need to find a different group to fundraise for. While I might not have agreed with that, it was nice to finally have a definitive answer after weeks of vague responses. We then sought the agreement and support from SportNL to fundraise on their behalf, and they would allocate the funds directly to the Canada Games Legacy Fund instead. Seems like an unnecessary added layer, but the lottery division was ok with it.

After getting approval for that, we have now been told that our Schedule A in our Articles of incorporation are not specific enough to what our charitable cause is. This is where things really started to go off the rails and why I am reaching out to you. We have been given absolutely no direction as to what needs to change, except that it isn't specific enough and doesn't articulate our charitable purpose. As far as I can tell, our Schedule A is quite specific (I've attached for your convenience if you care to review).

When I called the Company and Deeds line, I was told that they can't provide any feedback, and that I would need to get specifics from the lottery group and submit an amendment. So, now that there is radio silence from the lottery division, I am stuck in a revolving door of red tape and can't find my way out.

Minster, all we are trying to do as a Foundation is raise money to support the Canada Games Legacy Fund. Their team didn't have the capacity to take on additional ways to fundraise for the legacy fund, so we agreed that we would donate the net proceeds back to them after the fundraiser.

I'm just looking for a little guidance and assistance in achieving this. And unfortunately, after nearly **two full months**, I'm feeling defeated with the vague requirements that have been communicated by the lottery division. It has been an incredibly frustrating process. If there is something that doesn't meet their requirements, they **must** be able to clearly communicate why and suggest what needs to change.

I have copied MHA Jim Dinn on this email as well; as he is my MHA for St. John's Centre. I am hoping that we can work together to push this over the line so we can raise critical funds to help young athletes in the Province continue to take part in sports. I really do hate to send this email, I've always been one to work through these types of issues before, but I've reached my mental limit on this file after two months of nothing but pure frustration and red tape.

I look forward to hearing from one or both of you on how we might be able to achieve success.

Based on Mr. Skinner's email the main reason his first application was rejected was his choice of recipient for the funds. He was not permitted to fundraise for the 2025 Canada Summer Games. He would have to find a different group as the recipient of his fundraising efforts.

No other concern or problem was raised at that time.

Based on that, Mr. Skinner secured another recipient for his fundraising efforts. Presumably, the rest of the new application remained unchanged from the first.

This time, however, he was told that Schedule A in his organisation's Articles of Incorporation was not specific enough to what his organisation's charitable cause is. The Company and Deeds division is not permitted to provide feedback, and the Lottery Division is unwilling or unable to specify why Mr. Skinner's articles of incorporation are not specific enough. The irony of this situation is not lost on me.
