

Whereas GSU is facing financial instability and services continue to rely on SGS funding, further complicating the relationship & autonomy of the organization, it is the duty of the BOD to consider measures that advocate & assert our best interests using the few means available; I hereby call for the following motions to be adopted & actioned, to seek accountability for failure to act & re-allocate funds to our members.

- A. Motion A: Whereas CFS did not take immediate action to intervene during periods of suspected financial mismanagement to prevent the further deterioration of the GSU's financial situation; and

Whereas present and future generations of graduate students will suffer disproportionately due to this inaction; Be it resolved that GSU BOD formally requests that the debts observed by CFS-NL and CFS National be forgiven without prejudice through the proper means available to CFS, such as plenary debt sessions..

- B. Motion: In the event the debt is forgiven, whereas SGS holds an increasingly prevalent influence on GSU, not limited to funding \$30,000 in Academic & Campus life events with conditions, all funding retained from the forgiven debt plan shall be evenly re-allocated to Campus Life & Academic Events budgets to improve independence from MUN.
- C. Motion: Whereas the GSU BOD has the right to elect & nominate a BOD Chair; the GSU BOD shall hold a 2 week public nomination period for all BOD & those Interested in becoming a BOD for a vacant seat, so as the new 2026-2027 BOD may duly elect a BOD Chair. An interim chair shall be used until the BOD internal election, which is to be held no later than 5 days after the nomination period has concluded.
